Artwork should convey a positive message showing why people shouldn't litter, and/or how clean beaches benefit everyone and nature, and/or how a clean beach makes you feel.

The chosen winning artwork will be used in the Huntington Beach Anti-Litter Campaign and displayed throughout the city. The Mayor will announce the winner(s) at the February 2017 City Council meeting for recognition and prize presentation.

Contest Rules and Eligibility

Artists must be in Grades 3-12 and live or attend school within Huntington Beach city limits. Artwork should be original and not contain copyrighted characters or logos (e.g. Disney characters, Coca-Cola, etc.). Artwork can be computer generated but should not contain clip art or other unoriginal imagery.

Art should be dropped off at the City Manager's Office or emailed to HBArtContest@gmail.com. Include your name, grade, the school you attend, address, and email address (parental email address is ok) with your submission. Limit one submission per person.

Artwork will be judged by the Environmental Board and City Council Environmental Board liaisons on originality, artwork, and overall message and positivity.
