Profits from the Gift Shop are used by the Friends to help purchase non-budgeted library equipment, books and programs.

Donations of books are welcomed for the Used Book Sales center (main floor, Central Library).

Books may be dropped off at the Central Library (loading dock in back) or any of the four library branches. Tax deduction slips are available.
