#### **A.    PROJECT REVIEW (FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS)**

- A-1.    ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT NO. 08-008/GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 08-002/ZONING MAP AMENDMENT NO. 08-002/ZONING TEXT AMENDMENT NO. 08-002 (BEACH AND EDINGER CORRIDORS SPECIFIC PLAN) – Rosemary Medel, Associate Planner**

Rosemary Medel, Associate Planner, gave a brief overview of the project. She noted that the aim of the March 24, 2009 study session was to focus on Book I of the Specific Plan, the Community Intent. She said that the focus of tonight's study session would be to discuss Book II of the Specific Plan, Development Code.

Ms. Medel said that redevelopment areas would include the Five Points Center at Beach Blvd. and Ellis Avenue, and all of Edinger Avenue. She said Specific Plan goals include facilitating better use of public space, creating better walkability and

encouraging mixed-use projects. She also said that all existing uses within the Beach and Edinger Corridors will have the right of continued use.

Planning Manager Mary Beth Broeren noted that the Pacifica Community Specific Plan will be absorbed by the Beach and Edinger Corridors Specific Plan. Ms. Broeren also noted that for future development project requests, staff would be able to check the Beach and Edinger Corridors Specific Plan charts (staff report attachments 5.1 and 5.2) to see what is permitted in each area.

Commissioner Mantini asked about the Transit Center and if there are plans for expansion. Ms. Broeren noted that the Orange County Transit Authority Transit Center is not within the Beach and Edinger Corridors Specific Plan area.

Ms. Broeren directed the Planning Commission to the Comparison Development Standards chart (attachment 5.2) and asked for comments regarding density, Floor Area Ratio (FAR) and development standards.

Commissioner Speaker noted that Floor Area Ratio (FAR) doesn't factor into Form Based Code and Ms. Broeren concurred.

Director of Planning Scott Hess said that eight new zoning districts are being created as a result of the Beach and Edinger Corridors Specific Plan. He noted that three of these districts would be discussed at tonight's study session, with the other five to be addressed at future study sessions.

Mr. Broeren discussed the Specific Plan's proposed building setbacks, parking standards and configuration requirements. She noted that one of the goals of the Specific Plan is to create an environment where parking is directed to parking structures.

Commissioner Farley asked if staff had updates from the Police Department regarding parking behind buildings instead of in parking structures. Ms. Broeren noted that this issue was addressed in the program level Environmental Impact Report and that the Police and Fire Departments have reviewed the Beach and Edinger Corridors Specific Plan.

**A-2. GENERAL PLAN CONFORMANCE NO. 09-002 (EMERALD COVE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP) – Rosemary Medel, Associate Planner**

Rosemary Medel, Associate Planner, gave a brief overview of the project. She noted that the transfer of ownership is in compliance with the General Plan. She also said that this item will come before the Planning Commission as a non-public hearing item on May 12, 2009.

Commissioner Livengood asked about a possible rent increase and Deputy Director of Economic Development Kellee Fritzal said that there would be no increase in the rents.

Ms. Fritzal also noted that of the non-profit developers considered for this project, Jamboree Housing seemed to have the best credentials.

Director of Planning Scott Hess noted that the Black Bull Chophouse was issued a Notice of Violation for having their dance floor not clearly delineated, which is a violation of condition of approval No. 2b of CUP No. 06-020. Planning Manager Herb Fauland added that the Black Bull Chophouse is also in violation of condition of approval No. 3a, by failing to complete and submit the required noise analysis in a timely manner.
