**H. INFORMATIONAL ITEMS** – In an effort to keep commission informed, the following are updates on major projects/issues:

H.1. Overview of bluff Top Park Retaining Wall Repair – The damaged retaining wall at Bluff Top Park near 18<sup>th</sup> Street and PCH has been repaired. Temporary fencing at the location will remain in place until the end of the month. The engineering methods to retain the wall will be utilized to address any future erosion of the wall. No impacts to the upper and lower pathways occurred during the construction period.

H.2. Bartlett Park – Public Works staff have applied road base to the upper trail leading from the parking lot toward Yorktown Avenue. The material will provide better compaction, allowing for better access for safety and maintenance vehicles. Staff is also continuing work on the environmental documentation and construction drawings for Phase I of the master plan.

H.3. Play Equipment at Harbour View and Newland Parks – The play equipment and safety surfacing has been installed at Harbour View and Newland Parks. The new equipment now meets all ADA and Consumer Product Safety Commission guidelines.

H.4. South Beach Parking Lot Repairs – Resurfacing of the beach parking lot from Beach Boulevard to the pedestrian bridge in front of the Hyatt hotel has been completed and the area has re-opened for public parking. Repairs to the remaining portions of the lot will commence after the summer months in order to minimize impacts to the public.

H.5 Lake Park Clubhouse – Improvements at the Lake Park Clubhouse are complete. Improvements included new flooring throughout the building, new kitchen counters and cabinets, a new pass through window, new retro-fit windows and repainting of the interior. Cost for the work totaled \$30,360.00.
