Subject: Counterfeiting Arrests

Details:

While conducting follow-up investigation on a case originating in Huntington Beach involving counterfeit US Currency, detectives from the Huntington Beach Police Department along with agents from the United States Secret Service went to a motel in the city of Cypress.

Huntington Beach Police Detectives and the US Secret Service Agents were operating as part of the U.S. Secret Service Los Angeles Field Office Electronic Crimes Task Force while investigating this case. The Task Force is part of an established formal working relationship between the Huntington Beach Police Department, the United States Secret Service and a number of other law enforcement agencies from throughout the Los Angeles region formed to combat high tech crimes.

A Federal Search Warrant was served on a motel room in the city of Cypress. Investigating Detectives/Agents found a number of counterfeit bills in the process of being manufactured along with all the equipment needed to complete the process and also located a quantity of counterfeit US Currency.

Salvador Serrano Jr., age 40 from Corona, Ca. was arrested for a variety of charges including production of counterfeit US Currency and is in federal custody awaiting court proceedings.

Also arrested was Christine Ann Harrison, age 43 of Garden Grove, Ca. She is currently in custody at the Huntington Beach City Jail on charges of possessing a controlled substance.

No further details are being released at this time.
