On 3-11-12 at 0833 Hrs, Huntington Beach Officers responded to a commercial burglary that occurred at the Huntington Beach Surf and Sport shop located at 126 Main Street. The burglar(s) had shattered a window and stole approximately \$11,000.00 worth of watches, wallets and cash. The crime was discovered by the employees arriving for work.

Police detectives developed leads and identified Haddock as a suspect. Haddock had been arrested for similar types of commercial burglaries in 2009 and served time in prison. Haddock is presently on parole and on 3-13-12 detectives conducted a parole search at his residence in Westminster. Haddock was not at home, but a search revealed several stolen watches from stores in Costa Mesa and additional stolen property from the Huntington Surf and Sport. Several other items believed to be stolen property were also discovered.

On 3-13-12 at 1630 hours Haddock was spotted with Murphy in a hotel parking lot at 4881 Birch Street in Newport Beach, the Extended Stay America. A search of the hotel room revealed more stolen watches, narcotics and a loaded firearm. Both were taken into custody and booked at the Huntington Beach City Jail.

Detectives suspect that Haddock is responsible for at least 10 burglaries in Huntington Beach and at least 40 burglaries in Orange County since November of 2011.
