### **Counseling Resource**

The CSP, Inc. Sexual Assault Victim Services Program is the resource HBPD can offer the victims and family members for crisis counseling, on-going support counseling, and resources. Services are provided free of charge.

Sexual Assault Victim Services, Orange County's rape crisis center, is a component of Community Service Programs, Inc. (CSP), a non-profit human services agency. The program provides high quality and comprehensive services to victims of sexual crimes and their family members. Services include 24-hour hotline crisis counseling, crisis intervention and counseling services to victims and families to cope with the trauma of victimization and assist in the recovery process, accompaniment to court proceedings, orientation to the criminal justice system, and information/referral services to link clients with community resources.
