Subject: Fatal Traffic Collision

Details:

On Monday, October 24, 2016, at 4:53 a.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department responded to the area of Magnolia Street and Adams Avenue regarding a single vehicle traffic collision.

Arriving officers located a black 2013 Toyota Camry and the lone occupant, a deceased 25 year old male Hispanic from Moreno Valley, CA, still in the driver's seat. His name will not be released until next of kin can be notified.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the vehicle was traveling south on Magnolia Street south of Adams Avenue and collided with the center divider and struck a tree.

The investigation is ongoing and is being conducted by the HBPD Major Incident Reconstruction Team (M.I.R.T). No citations have been issued and no arrests have been made at this time. It is not known if alcohol was a factor.
