### **Details:**

Tuesday, June 28, 2016 at 9:37 p.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department responded to the area of Beach Boulevard and Newman Avenue regarding a traffic collision involving silver 2000 Dodge Caravan and a pedestrian.

Arriving officers located a critically injured white male in the roadway. He was transported to UCI Medical Center where he later succumbed to his injuries. The deceased has been identified as a 53 year old male; however his identity is being withheld until next of kin can be notified.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the pedestrian was crossing Beach Boulevard in a westerly direction at Newman Avenue as the Dodge was driving southbound Beach Boulevard, where the pedestrian was struck. Impairment does not appear to be a factor.

The investigation is ongoing and is being conducted by the HBPD Major Incident Reconstruction Team (M.I.R.T). No citations have been issued and no arrests have been made at this time.
