Details:

On March 23, 2013 at about 10:09 AM, the Huntington Beach Police Department received a report of a traffic collision on Bolsa Chica Street at the intersection of Pearce Drive. The arriving officers discovered a black unknown year motorcycle was travelling south on Bolsa Chica Street, when it collided with a black 2009 BMW, 335i, sedan. The BMW had been travelling east on Pearce Drive prior to the collision.

The 67 year old, female, driver of the BMW was uninjured. The 66 year old, male, driver of the motorcycle was injured and treated at the scene by Huntington Beach Fire Department Paramedics. He was transported to the UCI Medical Center, where he was treated for serious injuries.

HBPD Accident Reconstruction Officers responded to the collision scene and conducted the initial investigation. The driver of the BMW was cooperative and spoke to officers at the scene. No arrest or citation has been issued at this time, and the investigation into the cause of the collision is ongoing.
